



Specifiers' Product Identification Sheet

COVERAD (IR): White, Impact Resistant Low Surface Temperature Polymer Radiator Covers (Class 1 Fire rating), with full width hanging supports.

Application: *General usage in Institutional and Commercial Buildings where the public has access. Preferred in wet areas, e.g. bathrooms, toilets, showers, swimming pools (in conjunction with cast aluminium radiators), laboratories, wet maintenance areas, schools (flexible on impact). Maintenance and rust free.*

Specification download:

"Supply **COVERAD (IR)** uPVC 4.5mm. thick, self colour white, UVA Resistant, heat formed and welded, floor-standing, LST radiator covers to provide 43C° protection to radiators as specified elsewhere. To be installed to the manufacturer's Installation Instructions."

COVERAD (HR): White High Impact Resistant, Class 1 Fire, Low Surface Temperature Polymer Radiator Covers with full width hanging supports.

Application: *Used in areas of high abuse where vandalism and violence is regularly experienced. Fitted with security screws. Optional extra – can be fitted with "Broadmoor Mesh" to eradicate ligature point. May be used in all the above situations plus "Secure Units", Police Stations, halfway houses, Prisons, Educational Units, Psychiatric Units, Alcohol and Drug Dependency Units, Customs holding areas.*

Specification download:

"Supply **COVERAD (HR)** uPVC 4.5mm. thick, self colour white, UVA resistant, heat formed and welded, floor-standing, LST radiator covers to provide 43C° protection to radiators as specified or installed elsewhere. To be installed to the manufacturer's Installation Instructions."

COVERAD (ST): White (RAL 9010) 1.2mm, 1.5mm or 2.0mm, Zintek coated CR4 sheet steel, CNC stamped, folded and welded from one piece sheet. Cleaned and phosphor coated, Du Pont "TEX" powder-coated, round-edge LST radiator covers with full width hanging supports. Class Zero Fire rating.

Application: *Thousands of these covers have been installed over the past 13 years in large numbers of the UK's major Hospitals, social housing areas, schools, clinics, LA buildings, Private Health Industry premises, Hotels, nurseries, etc., to meet Health and Safety requirements, D.D.A. Acts, Safety at Work Act, NHS, etc.*

Specification Download:

"Supply **COVERAD (ST)** Low Surface Temperature White powder-coated (RAL9010) floor standing radiator covers, in 1.2mm, 1.5mm or 2.00mm (delete as required) Steel, to provide 43° protection to radiators as specified or installed elsewhere. To be installed to the manufacturer's installation Instructions."

COVERAD POLYMER PIPECOVER (PC): White uPVC, Class 1 Fire rating, maintenance-free bespoke pipecover to provide 43° protection to pipework as specified or installed elsewhere and to complement all Coverad radiator covers.

Easy, simple installation saves labour time and guarantees an excellent finished product which is very easy to clean.

Can also be supplied in **Impact Resistant (PCIR)** or **High Impact Resistant (PCHR)** polymer, as situation demands. Bespoke profiles also available.

Application: *Miles of this pipecover has been supplied to cover and protect pipework and ducting in every conceivable type of situation from Hospitals to Cruise Liners. Simply state the size and shape required for an immediate quotation. Can be used internally or externally. Simple and speedy installation, saving the high labour costs of the timber alternative. Maintenance-free.*

Specification download:

"Supply **COVERAD (PC)** Unslotted pipecover in white self-colour 4.5mm uPVC, Class 1, heat folded, to cover pipework in the specified areas. Slotted pipecover is also available (**COVERAD PCS**). To be installed to the manufacturer's Installation Instructions."

COVERAD STRONGARD CABINETS (S): White Polymer or Steel safety cabinets manufactured from tough polycarbonates or steel with lockable clear polycarbonate viewing screens. Cabinets are made to customer requirements, sizes, etc.

Application: *Frequently used in difficult areas such as Psychiatric units, Special Schools, Prisons, etc. where patients can destroy electrical equipment and/or cause personal harm. These virtually unbreakable cabinets incorporate the enormous experience gained by Coverad Ltd. in the Secure Industry where televisions, video equipment, P.C.s, etc. are at constant risk of damage or theft when not protected. The cabinets are firmly secured to the building and form no risk as a weapon. Electrical equipment can be controlled by remote handsets and very limited access made available in the design if the customer so wishes. Ideal for A & E Units, etc.*

Specification download:

“Supply **COVERAD STRONGARD CABINETS (S)** in White Polycarbonate or Steel (1.5 or 2 mm.) *(delete as required)* with Polycarbonate viewing panel to Drawing no. Coverad Quote no. dated This equipment to be very securely fixed to the building to alleviate any possibility of movement, as agreed with the Architect and client.”



STRONGARD WALL CORNER PROTECTION (WP): White Polymer Angles with rounded tops and bevelled edges. Can be screwed and/or glued to buildings to give excellent long-term protection.

Application: *Corner protectors for use in any building prone to damage from wheeled equipment. Highly resistant to hospital beds, trolleys and wheelchairs, rust-proof so unaffected by floor washing. No sharp edges and easy to clean. Class 1 fire rated.*

“Supply **COVERAD STRONGARD WP** Protective corners, as shown on Architect's drawing no., dated”



COVERAD STRONGARD MIRRORS (M): Coverad Mirrors are manufactured from 3mm, 4.5mm or 5mm Polycarbonate sheet Mirror and are virtually unbreakable. Can be supplied in any size or shape, e.g. flat or domed, CNC shapes with bevelled edges, etc.

Application: *Coverad Mirrors are used in difficult and violent areas where damage is frequent. May be used for personal grooming or security, i.e. domed for wall, corner or ceiling in secure suites or corridors.*
